the 155 horses that came under hammer just 29 were sold. The aggregate for the entire day came in at \in 67,000, the average was \in 2,310 and the median \in 1,400.

Unfortunately the session illustrated the complete lack of demand for horses occupying the lowest reaches of the market and mirrored the trend that has been evident at most other thoroughbred auctions for some time.

The top price of the day, at €6,500, was a yearling son by **Indian River**, who is the sire of last month's Hennessy Gold Cup hero **Madison Du Berlais**. Consigned by Rathmore Farm on behalf of Hazel Hatton, the February-born gelding (**Lot 79**) is a half-brother to two useful winners including the very capable Listed-winning chaser **Strawberry** (**Beneficial**).

Not long afterwards Ned Comer signed for a €5,500 Oscar yearling hailing from Moanmore Stables. Lot 107 is out of an unraced daughter of Needle Gun. His family goes back to a pair of tough and classy staying chasers in Wicked Crack and Whats The Crack.

Earlier in the day T J Kidd looked to pick up good value when he spent €5,000 on a **Presenting** filly (**Lot 40**) from a decent family. The Gerry Mullins-owned four-year-old is a half-sister to the Listed-placed bumper mare **Ring Back** (**Bob Back**) and they are out of a winning daughter of **Oats in Ardrom** (**Ardross**). The latter is a full-sister to a Beecher Chase victor in **Feels Like Gold**.

Meanwhile J Kelly spent €4,500 on a **Great Palm** yearling (**Lot 73**) consigned by Abbey Leix Stud Farm. He is a half-brother to the dual winner and Gr.3-placed chaser **Urban Rebel (New Frontier)** and their dam is a half-sister to the dam of the ten-times scorer and Gr.1 Supreme Novice Hurdle-third **Castle Sweep**.

Trainer Andrew McNamara who was amongst the winners at Clonmel on Sunday made his presence felt when going to €4,000 for a **Shernazar** three-year-old belonging to James Roberts. **Lot 53** is out of a three-times winning daughter of **Broken Hearted** in **Five Of Hearts**.

There was just one **Kayf Tara** foal in the catalogue and he was knocked down to Haristown Stables for \in 4,000. The grandson of **Sadler's Wells** is the third foal out of an unraced **Alflora** mare, who is a half-sister to a winner over fences last year.
