The third edition of the Osarus Breeze-Up sale will take place at Pornichet racecourse on the West coast of France on Tuesday, 29th April.

The sale will feature 81 French-bred two-year-olds, eligible for French owners' premiums, all of which will breeze on the all-weather track from 8.30am and the sale will begin at 1.30pm the same day.

The catalogue features two-year-olds by proven sires, including American Post (Lot 3), Carlotamix (Lot 31, Lot 43 and Lot 70), Dalakhani (Lot 76), Deportivo (Lot 68), Diamond Green (Lot 51 and Lot 78), Dylan Thomas (Lot 38), Early March (Lot 12, Lot 13, Lot 22, Lot 46 and Lot 62), Falco (Lot 11 and Lot 65), Footstepsinthesand (Lot 1 and Lot 64), Kings Best (Lot 21, Lot 24 and Lot 61), Librandtist (Lot 17 and Lot 34), Lord Du Sud (Lot 53), Martaline (Lot 8 and Lot 49), Panis (Lot 19 and Lot 72), Spirit One (Lot 29), Stormy River (Lot 2), Sunday Break (Lot 26 and Lot 74), Westerner (Lot 48), Whipper (Lot 45, 54 and Lot 81).

Second Crop Sires, Aqlaam (Lot 28 and Lot 41), Le Havre (Lot 6 and Lot 57), Mastercraftsman (Lot 63), Naaqoos (Lot 66), Soldier Of Fortune (Lot 30), Yeats (Lot 79) and Zambezi Sun (Lot 36), are also represented.

The catalogue also features two-year-olds by first season sires such as Air Chief Marshal (Lot 4, Lot 44 and Lot 47), Lope De Vega (Lot 42), Silver Frost (Lot 73), Siyouni (Lot 9), Vertigineux (Lot 23, Lot 77 and Lot 80).

Over the last couple of years, the Osarus Breeze-up sale has produced winners such as **Plaine Monceau**, a filly by **One Cool Cat**, purchased by Michel Gentile for €8,000 in 2012 and who has earned over €111,000, **Bhaktapur** (**Naaqoos**), bought for €16,000 by MAB Agency on behalf of SAF Canarias, who has won two of his three starts, **Singapore Mist**, bought for €7,000 by trainer Thierry Lemer, winner at Deauville at two, **Alicenora**, a filly by **Astronomer Royal**, consigned by Haras du Chêne in 2013, who won the Prix Kantar last year at Saint Cloud and who is now entered in the Gr.1 Prix de Diane (French Oaks).

Among other winners from the sale figure: Barbe à Box, Camerlingue, Cheg, Dekatmie, Draka, Gangnam Style, Gangster Squad, Indian Walk, Lorme, Love Chop, Mamy Way, Maxireporter, Noctuelle, Spoulgas and Vilna.
